Prose :	2 prose to a maximum of 2000 words
Postcard Prose:	up to 5 postcard prose – 200 to 350 words

Please attach your submission in MS Word format and ALSO paste the submission in the body of your email in case of formatting incompatibilities.

If submitting by surface mail, an e-copy must be available in case of acceptance. Submissions must be typed, double-spaced on one side of the page, with at least 1"margins. Good quality photocopies or computer printouts are acceptable. On your envelope please print your full name, type of submission and complete address.

Manuscripts may be rejected if they do not adhere to format guidelines.

We will only respond to submissions by email. If you want your manuscript returned to you, include a SASE with adequate Canadian postage.
